4. Management reserves the right to cancel or change the tournament.
5. Winners may choose to be paid in casino chips or cash.
6. Winners must show a valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries without a U.S. tax treaty will be subject to withholding. Pursuant to IRS regulations, W-2G or 1042 forms will be issued for all tournament winnings of \$5,000 or more (net of buy-in amount).
7. \$95 of the \$600 Buy-In is withheld for house fees (Rake + Staff). Prize pool consists of \$505 of every \$600 Buy In.

9. All pre-registered stacks will be in play at the start of the event.
